Doctor Frederic Braccini studied medicine in Nice and is a member of The European Academy of Facial Plastic Surgery, the French Society of Plastic and Aesthetic Surgery of the Face and Neck and other surgical and anti-ageing associations. Dr Braccini has been published in numerous peer review journals, speaks on surgical and aesthetic matters, and practises in Nice.
