visible scars, not even telltale scars behind the ears, which have long accompanied other face-lift procedures.

•Intense Pulse Light (IPL).

"Laser resurfacing is extremely popular right now," Dr. Calabria told The ENQUIRER.

"But unfortunately, it leaves the patient with a shiny, waxy look. In some of the worst cases, the laser has burned patients' skin."

But this new laser avoids those problems. It is used to successfully treat age spots, sun-induced freckles,

broken capillaries, birthmarks and other skin imperfections. The IPL technology also been shifted away from the line of closure, the incisions will heal much better, leaving an almost invisible scar.
